

## **2. SELECTION OF STUDENTS FOR PARTICIPATION IN THE ACADEMIC MOBILITY PROGRAM**

*Extract from the Regulations on the NaUKMA Students of the Bachelor and Master's Programs Participation in the Programs of International Academic Mobility, approved by the decision of the NaUKMA Academic Council 27 September 2018 (amended version) and confirmed by the Order of the NaUKMA President #509 of 23 November 2018.*

2.1. The list of the documents, to be submitted as part application for participation the students' academic mobility programs and application procedure are defined by these Regulations, agreements between NaUKMA and partner higher educational institutions, individual learning agreements between NaUKMA, partner higher educational institutions and students.

2.2. To participate in the programs of academic mobility NaUKMA students should:

- confirm high academic performance for the previous period of studies at their Bachelor programs of studies (students of at least 2nd-3d year of studies and those who have reached age of 18 by the time of mobility are allowed to participate in mobility programs). High academic performance equals to average GPA not lower than 80 for the previous period of studies.
- demonstrate high academic performance for the previous period of studies at the Master's programs of studies. High academic performance equals to average GPA not lower than 80 for the previous period of studies
- have signed corporate agreement and perform obligations of the agreement for the previous period of studies (students of Master's program should only submit signed corporate agreement at the time of application)
- receive positive recommendations from their department for participation in the mobility program. For the duration of credit mobility and upon its completion students should remain registered with their NaUKMA programs and should remain students of the same level of studies.

2.3. If other is not defined by selection requirements of particular program or project of credit academic mobility, selection of participants for the credit mobility programs among NaUKMA students is performed by the NaUKMA selection committee, formed by the NaUKMA international office with participation of international faculty members, representative of the applicants' departments, and representatives of the student self-government.

The following criteria are considered by the selection committee for selecting NAUKMA students for participation in international credit mobility program:

- academic performance
- knowledge of language of studies at receiving institution
- motivation
- social activity / research work involvement.

Nominations of NaUKMA students for participation in international credit mobility programs, made by the NaUKMA, should confirmed by receiving institution.

2.4. Decision on NaUKMA students' participation in mobilities, which have the format of language studies or research internship, is done by the applicant's department with involvement of international office and applicants dean's office with consideration of mobility program content, NaUKMA study requirements, duration of a program (usually mobilities of this type should not exceed 1 month) etc.

All selection committees' decisions should be confirmed by minutes of selection committee meetings.
